

SUBJECT: OPERATION OF MOTOR-DRIVEN VEHICLES AND OTHER MEANS OF TRANSPORT ON DISTRICT PROPERTY

The use of motor-driven vehicles, including cars, snowmobiles, mini-bikes, motorcycles, all-terrain vehicles (ATV's) and other such vehicles is prohibited on any school grounds or areas except for authorized school functions or purposes.

Students are permitted to park on school premises as a matter of privilege, not as a right. The District retains authority to conduct routine patrols of student parking lots and inspections of the exteriors of student automobiles on school property. The interiors of student vehicles may be inspected whenever a school authority has reasonable suspicion to believe that illegal or unauthorized materials are contained inside. Such patrols and inspections may be conducted without notice, without student consent, and without a search warrant. Further notice of this shall be provided annually to the students in the student handbook.

Student Pickup

Parents or caregivers picking up ~~their~~ children in cars at any District location must park in the designated areas for personal transport. ~~East Side, West Side, and Fowler shall not enter the bus loading areas. At East Side they shall park on Gleason Street and take the children from the Gleason Street sidewalks only; at West Side they shall park in the circle drive or on Wilson Street picking up children from adjoining walks; at Fowler they shall use the southeast parking lot only.~~

Use of Bicycles and Other Means of Transport

The use of bicycles, skateboards, and other human powered transport ~~Bicycle riding~~ on school grounds at any hour of the day or time of the year is strictly forbidden. Students riding bicycles to school will dismount in the parking lots or as they reach the sidewalks and push the bicycles to these parking areas.
